Receipts and Payments

Membership income for the 2 months of £1.6k reflects the new members in the period.

Repairs were high in the period with £720 for repairing the carpet on Court 4 and £442 for new security lighting for the car park area.

Other expenses include £720 LTA registration fees .

Forecast

I attach a forecast for the remaining 2 months of the year and comparing the full year forecast to the original budget.

Membership fees for the balance of the year have been estimated to show a shortfall of £2.4k from budget. The court resurfacing cost an additional £2.7k . R&M incl the bird spikes are above budget but partially offset by reduced other expenses.

The sinking fund is predicted to be short by £2.7k and club funds are predicted to be over by £4.4k.

We discussed the management account and budgeting and were agreed everything is in good order – the accounts actually seem slightly better than expected earlier in the year.
